ADDENDUM 01: ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED

- 1. Proof of residence.
- 2. A written endorsement from the bishop or leader of your church in support of your plans to study theology and become a pastor. Please use the form provided (Addendum 04). This endorsement must be completed by the bishop or church leader and sent directly to the LTS.
- 3. South African candidates must have passed the National Senior Certificate (matric) with an M-score of at least 20, and submit proof of having done so, or else be a graduate from another nationally accredited tertiary institution. Proof of highest academic qualification attained must be submitted.
- 4. Foreign candidates must have completed a minimum of 12 years of schooling and have their qualification evaluated and verified by the South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA, www.saqa.org.za) as essentially equivalent to that of the South African National Senior Certificate. Such proof of the applicable SAQA certification must be submitted.
- Candidates must have achieved at least an E in English as home language or first additional language, or else provide proof of English competency by means of a successfully completed National Benchmark Test (https://www.nbt.ac.za). The applicable certificate of completion must be submitted.
- 6. Police clearance from your local police station.
- 7. A health certificate signed by your medical doctor not older than 3 months.
- 8. Proof of medical aid coverage / health insurance.
- 9. Photocopy of your ID/Passport with a recognizable photo.
- 10. Foreign students who have been admitted will need to submit a copy of their visa on arrival for administrative purposes.
- 11. If married, please attach a copy of your marriage certificate.

This completed form must be returned to the offices of the LTS in Tshwane together with all the additional requirements $\underline{\text{three months}}$ before your admission to the Seminary program, which starts on the 1^{st} Tuesday in February of every year.
